



EfficienSea2 Workshop: How to run MCP (Maritime Connectivity Platform) - formerly known as the Maritime Cloud -

21-22 November 2017
at IALA Headquarters in France

The EfficienSea2 Project is holding a workshop on the Maritime Connectivity Platform (MCP) at the IALA Offices in St Germain en Laye, France, from 21 to 22 November, 2017.

BACKGROUND

The MCP (Maritime Connectivity Platform), formerly known as the Maritime Cloud, is a communication framework that enables efficient, secure, reliable and seamless electronic information exchange among all authorized maritime stakeholders across available communication systems. This framework is currently under development in a collaboration between different projects – EfficienSea2 (EU), STM validation project (EU) and the SMART Navigation project (Korea). As a partner in the EfficienSea 2 project, IALA is participating in the work on maturing the MCP, in order to assess its potential as the generic communication framework for e-navigation at large. It is assumed that the MCP is desirable and on this basis the workshop will discuss the best options with regard to governance and business model.

TOPICS

The workshop will cover the need, purpose, user requirements, business model and governance of the MCP.

OBJECTIVE

The workshop will address the implementation of the MCP with a focus on reviewing governance and business model options, identifying preferred governance and business models and a related exploitation plan for global information exchange. It is anticipated that the workshop will provide participants with a good understanding of the MCP concept and develop a forward plan for its globalisation.

PROCESS

The workshop will provide a forum for discussion between stakeholder groups aimed at reaching a consensus on key points. It will include presentations on various aspects relevant to the MCP as well as workshop sessions. The working language for the workshop will be English.

VENUE

The venue will be in the IALA Offices, 10 rue des Gaudines, 78100 St Germain en Laye, France.

ATTENDEES

Participants at the Workshop will include:

- Experts from industry and academia, e-navigation solution providers, developers and project partners.
- Stakeholders from EfficienSea2, e-Navigation Underway, IALA, and other interested parties.
