Associate Membership - Bermuda

The government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (the United Kingdom) would like to request Associate Membership of the International Organization for Marine Aids to Navigation for Bermuda in accordance with the International Convention Article 2.3 and Article 7.7(j) and the draft General Regulations Article 2.3.

Bermuda, an archipelago of 181 islands in the North Atlantic Ocean, is a self-governing parliamentary democracy which enacts statutes on all domestic legal issues and has responsibility for coastal state obligations regarding marine aids to navigation.
