# Terms of Reference

1. Provide a mechanism for *timely interaction/communication* between the committees.

  - scheduling of key Tasks of interest to both committees.



3. Identify options for *greater coordination /integration* in the delivery of key tasks relating to the role and function of both committees
4. Identify *gaps/issues* that may impact on ensuring *greater coordination, integration and productivity* with regards to the development of IALA guidance on VTS and the emerging concept of e-Navigation.



5. Provide advice to IALA with regards to how best the *work programmes and priorities* of each Committee could be better *coordinated/integrated* to maximize outcomes.
6. To provide a forum to *communicate a common understanding of the Tasks* being progressed by the respective Committees.
7. To provide an equitable (unbiased/balanced) forum that *facilitates members to express their views and opinions*.
