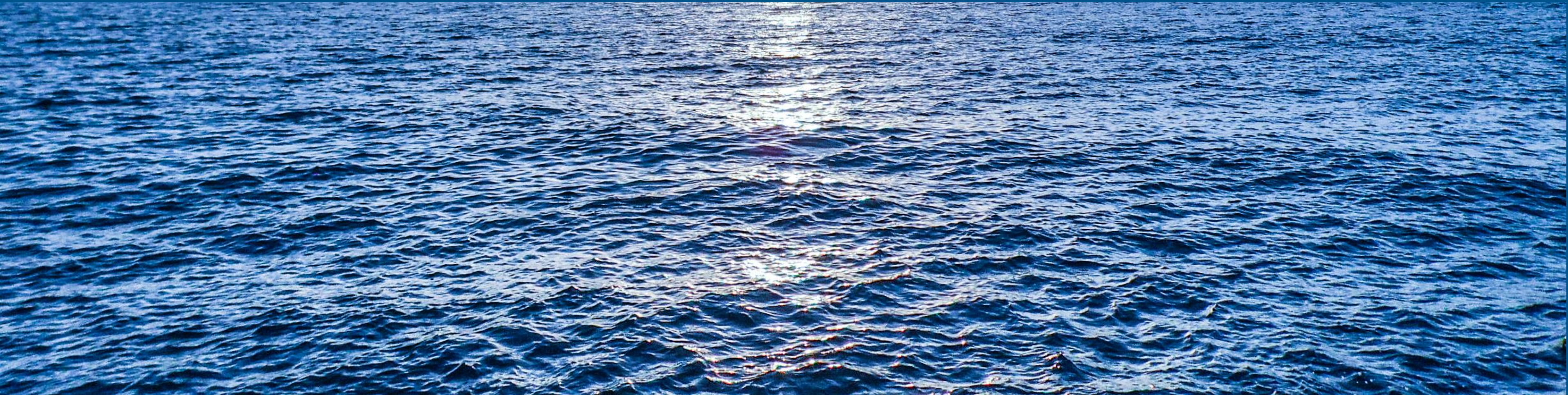

With a legacy of knowledge, hospitality, and global partnerships, India is proud to welcome the IALA Council and Member states — to connect, collaborate, and create the future together.

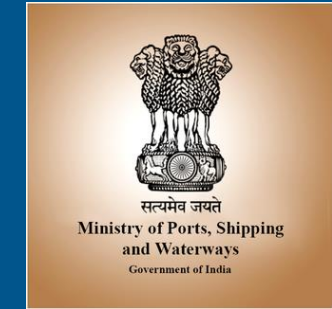

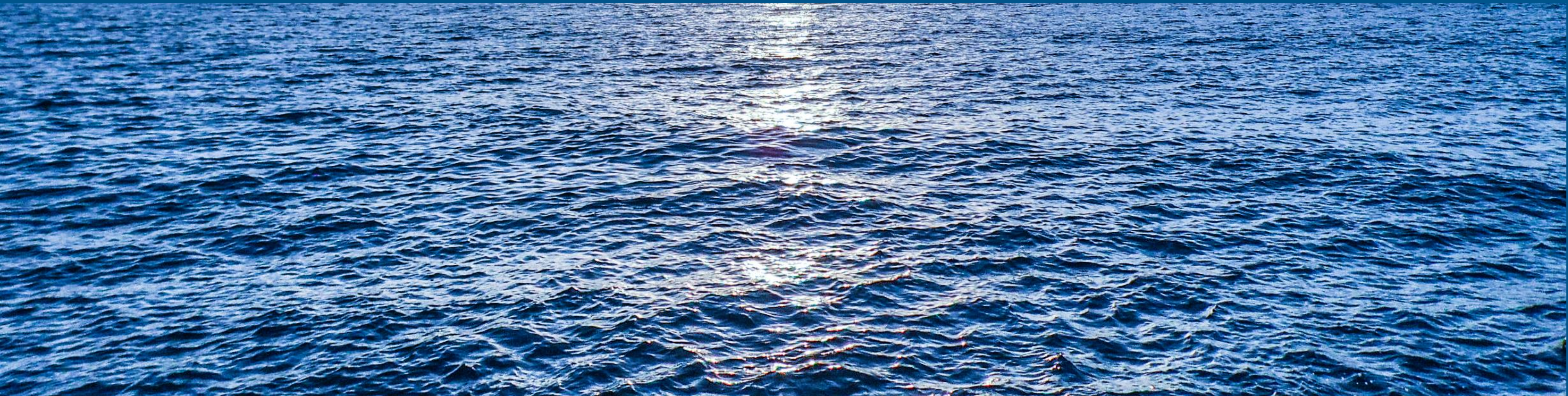
DEPICTING THE VENUE OF IALA CONFERENCE IN INDIA 2027

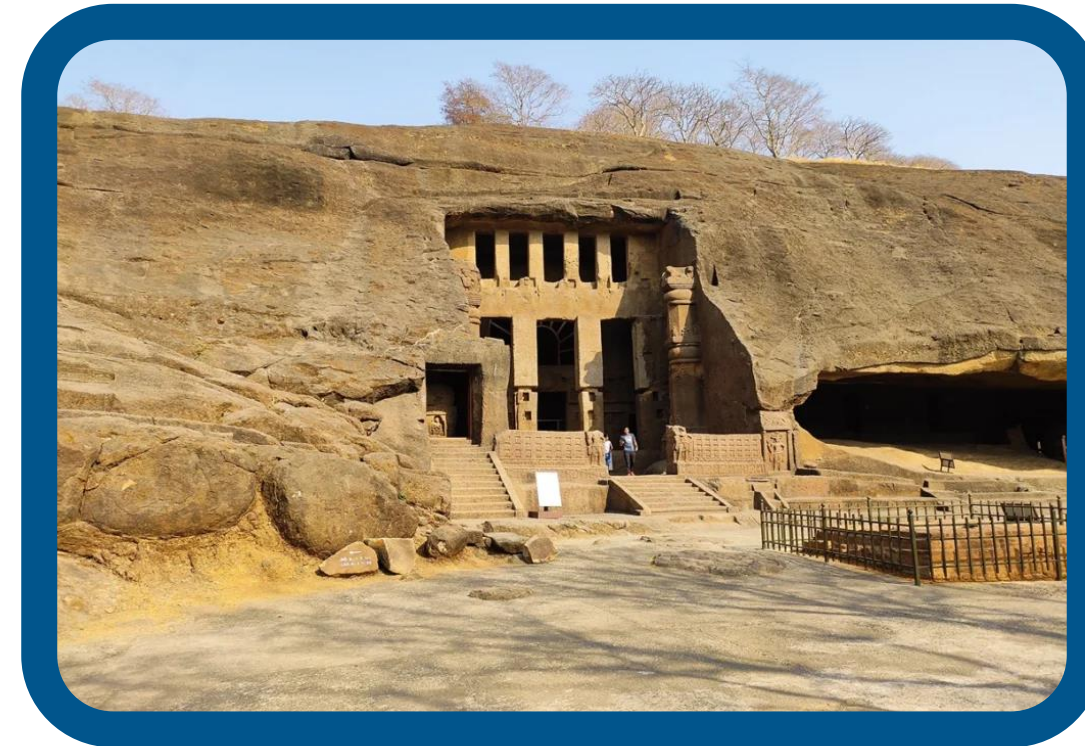

INTEGRATION OF VTMS AT 12 MAJOR PORTS

- Major Ports in India are providing VTMS services in the port area.
- DGLL providing VTS network in the Gulf of Kutch covering 16000 Sq.km.
- This project will facilitate integrated maritime traffic picture of all the ports, at a single point.
- This will improve maritime domain awareness and help in effective traffic planning along coast of India.
- DGLL, India under Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways undertaken the integration of VTMS of 12 Major Ports.



INTEGRATION OF VTMS AT 12 MAJOR PORTS



- Uninterrupted connectivity of all the VTMSs shall be made from the VTMS at major ports to the DGLL's National Data Centre (NDC), Mumbai, through reliable communication means with provision of redundancy.
- VTMS data from each of the Major Port, in IVEF format (IALA Recommendation R0145) will be transferred to NDC Mumbai, for integration.
- The integrated VTMS data will be transferred to user.
