15.1 – Applications for Membership

Note by the Secretariat

1. BACKGROUND

Since the last Council meeting in June, and in accordance with the General Regulations Article 2, the Secretariat received **6** new applications. **5** for Affiliate Industrial membership and **1** for Affiliate membership. **2** of them were provisionally accepted and are awaiting Council endorsement. **4** are awaiting Council approval and among them, two are subject to China's support.

2. APPLYING ORGANIZATIONS AWAITING ENDORSEMENT

2.1 For Affiliate Industrial membership

- **Gatehouse Maritime A/S, Denmark (4DENM08).** This organization is well known in IALA as well as its expertise in AIS network monitoring and maritime communications technology. They were formerly member from 2004 to 2022. The application was received on 15 July. The fee for this year is settled.
- **AAC Clyde Space, Sweden (4SWED12).** This organization provides small satellite technologies and services that enable businesses, governments and educational organisations to access high-quality, timely data from space. The application was received on. The fee for this year is settled.

3. APPLYING ORGANIZATIONS AWAITING APPROVAL

3.1 For Affiliate Industrial membership

- **Shandong Province Lenrinc Technology Development Co., Ltd. China.** This organization has showing interest in IALA as a user of its guidelines for some years now. They recently decided to become a full member. They are specialized in the design and manufacturing of AtoN equipment including Marine lighting, and UHmwPE Buoys. The application was received on August 1st and is awaiting support from China.
- **Cosco Shipping Technology Co; Ltd. China.** This organization is a technology subsidiary of Cosco Shipping Group. They develop technology capacities which serve as digitalization service for the shipping industry. The application was received on 16 June after they attended the VTS Committee in March as Observer. Support is awaited from China.
- **Lloyd's List Intelligence, the United Kingdom.** This organization is a well-established maritime data analytics company, operating a global network of AIS stations. They also look into VDES



applications. They raised interest in membership further to discussions with the Technical Operation Manager. The application was received on 30 September.

3.2 For Affiliate membership

- **Tanger Med Port Authority, Morocco.** By a Royal Decree in 2010, this organization was given the responsibilities of the management and development of Tanger Port infrastructure, coordination and Port community facilitation, ensuring the reliability and performance of services provided to the port platform's clients. They were convinced of the importance of having their own membership for greater visibility after participating in all technical committees under the auspices of the Associate member. The application was received on 20 October.
