15.3 – Membership update and Termination

Note by the Secretary-General

1. BACKGROUND (updated)

The following is an update since the last posting on the actions undertaken by the Secretariat previously and a proposal for membership terminations.

2. MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

The Secretariat continues to actively remind the members of the importance of settling the annual contributions and fees by due date to help the organization meet its objectives and cope with the changes ahead. To those who have not met their financial obligations for the year 2024 consecutively to the waiver of prior debts by the Secretary General in November 2024, the Secretariat has applied the December Council decision to suspend their rights to participate in the IALA Technical Committees in 2025.

In this regard, the Secretariat wishes to inform the Council of Tanzania Port Authority response to the final reminder informing them of a possible termination at this session if their financial obligations were not met. Payment of the fee of the year 2024 has been paid in full and the 2025's partially. Tanzania Port Authority was therefore removed from the list of membership termination.

To date, the **percentage of the members** which have settled the **2024's** contributions is **86%**, taking into consideration the resignations and the terminations.

However some members have not made any effort to settle their debts despite these measures and several reminders. In accordance with Art. 2.11(b) of the General Regulations, these members are now in the position to have their membership terminated:

3. MEMBERSHIP TERMINATIONS PROPOSAL

- **Chittagong Dry Dock Limited, Bangladesh (4BANG01)**, Affiliate Industrial member: since this organization became a member in September 2022, only the fee for the period that year has been settled.
- **Dockyard and Engineering Works Limited, Bangladesh (4BANG02)**, Affiliate Industrial member: this organization has been a member since September 2022. Only the fee for the period that year has been settled.
- **Salvage Certificação, Projetos e Serviços Offshore, Brazil (4BRAZ05)**, Affiliate Industrial member: since this organization became a member in November 2022, no contributions have been settled.
- **Marine Navais & Solar Auto Pv Ltd , India (4INDI01)**, Affiliate Industrial member: this organization was the first Indian Industrial member of IALA. After a few years' break, they



rejoined IALA in 2016. Since 2023, no fees have been settled. They were reminded that India been the host of the next conference, regularising their situation to remain a member can only be of mutual benefits.

- **Malsa Equipos Industriales S.A de CV, Mexico (4MEXI02)**, Affiliate Industrial member: This organization which has been a member since July 2022 has only settled the contribution for the period that year.
- **Oceans Works Pacific Limited, Papua New Guinea (4PAPU04)**, Affiliate Industrial member: Since they joined IALA in October 2022, this organization has never settled any contributions.
- **Ducksung Ocean Development Co., Ltd, Rep. of Korea (4RCOR16)**, Affiliate Industrial member: This organization has been a member since November 2021. Contributions from the year 2023 have not been settled.
- **Albatroz Apoio Marítimo Portuário Ltda, Brazil (3BRAZ07)**, Affiliate member: No contributions have been settled by this organization since they joined in November 2022.
- **Dongnan University, China, (3CHIN03)**: Affiliate member: This organization has been a member since 2019. No contributions were settled from the year 2023.
- **Abu Dhabi Marine Operations and Services Company LLC, United Arab Emirates (3UNAE03)**, Affiliate member: This organization has been a member since 2016. Contributions from the year 2023 have not been settled.
