9.3 – Membership contribution status

1. STATUS OF MEMBERSHIP

As of 31 October 2025, IALA welcomed 22 new members, including 16 Affiliate Industrial members, five Affiliate members and one new Member State (Libya).

During the year, IALA recorded nine resignations, two mergers due to the change of status, and 16 terminations effective on 1 January 2025. This resulted in a decrease in the numbers of members as at 31 October 2025 (346 in total compared to 351 last year).

A list of outstanding membership balances is provided in Annex 9.3.1.

As an exceptional measure due to the change of status and in order to facilitate the transfer of membership from the association to the Organization, last year the Secretary-General granted a waiver of arrears to all members on condition that they pay their contribution/fees for 2024.

Despite numerous reminders, some members (those indicated in red in the annex) have not responded or paid their dues. The financial impact of the proposed terminations amounts to € 76,000 for the year 2025.

The revenue budget for membership in 2025 had anticipated that some members would not honor their debts or would pay late. The collection rate generally corresponds to 80% of the total amount invoiced.

The decision to terminate membership for non-payment will be considered under item 15 of the agenda.
