From PAP 28: Request for advice on how to manage hosted IALA websites and non-IALA websites linked to IALA

Background

The IALA Policy Advisory Panel had on the Agenda for its 28th session held on 1-3 October 2014 an item on IALA Websites hosted by IALA Members of external Websites linked to the IALA one.

The corresponding extract from the PAP report reads as follows:

5.5 Websites linked to IALA website

Michael Card led a general discussion on websites linked to the IALA website.

- *It was noted that e-Navigation.net is an IALA website hosted by DMA;*
- *The Academy allows use of the IALA logo for training certification in accordance with the WWA model courses;*
- *The value and need for careful branding of IALA.*

Action

The IALA Secretariat is requested to prepare an audit of hosted websites and linked websites.

The LAP is requested to advise the Secretariat on how to manage hosted IALA websites and non-IALA websites linked to IALA.

The LAP is requested to provide wording for an IALA disclaimer for links to other websites.

Finally, a Website that claims to be an IALA portal, www.e-navigation.net is not linked to the IALA Website. This one is intended to give all necessary information about e-Navigation and is used in particular to register for the e-Navigation Underway conferences.

Action requested from LAP

The LAP is invited to advise IALA on how to manage these non IALA hosted Websites.
