## **From PAP 28: Request to provide wording for an IALA disclaimer for links to other Websites**

### **Background**

The IALA Policy Advisory Panel had on the Agenda for its 28<sup>th</sup> session held on 1-3 October 2014 an item on IALA Websites hosted by IALA Members of external Websites linked to the IALA one.

The corresponding extract from the PAP report reads as follows:

#### ***5.5 Websites linked to IALA website***

*Michael Card led a general discussion on websites linked to the IALA website.*

- *It was noted that e-Navigation.net is an IALA website hosted by DMA;*
- *The Academy allows use of the IALA logo for training certification in accordance with the WWA model courses;*
- *The value and need for careful branding of IALA.*

#### ***Action***

*The IALA Secretariat is requested to prepare an audit of hosted websites and linked websites.*

*The LAP is requested to advise the Secretariat on how to manage hosted IALA websites and non-IALA websites linked to IALA.*

***The LAP is requested to provide wording for an IALA disclaimer for links to other websites.***

### **Links to other Websites**

There different categories of links to other Websites:

- Links to hosted IALA Websites
- Links to external Websites providing services for IALA
- Links to members' Websites or sister organisations

**Action requested from LAP**

The LAP is invited to suggest a suitable disclaimer text where appropriate, bearing in mind that the disclaimer page in the IALA Website still displays “Content to follow...”
