➤ Japan proposed WRC-23 new agenda items to APG19-5 meeting

R-Mode: To consider regulatory provisions for modernization of the Global Maritime Distress and Safety System and related to the implementation of e-navigation in accordance with a new version of Resolution 361 (WRC-15)
