Cooperation Agreement between _____ and the International Association of marine Aids to Navigation and Lighthouse Authorities (IALA)

(20XX)

The International Association of Marine Aids to Navigation and Lighthouse Authorities (IALA) and _____, being aware of the growing need for close co-operation in the technical and regional development activities of common interest to both organizations and their Members and member states, and in accordance with XXXX / IALA meeting reports, (or council decisions etc) agree on the following:

- a) to continue their long standing co-operation in:
 - i) the development of maritime navigational services world-wide,
 - ii) the development of standards of mutual interest to both organizations and
 - iii) the implementation and support for joint proposals and initiatives.

This co-operation includes aspects of XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX(e.g radar and radar beacon developments, VTS and AIS technology) and other related aids to navigation technologies.

Co-operation aspects cover all areas of mutual interest and include, specifically:

- a) co-operation on an equal basis in joint subsidiary bodies that may be established by the two organizations, with or without other co-sponsoring bodies;
- b) co-operation in the exchange of information of mutual interest to the two organizations and co-operation in the use, integration, promotion and the dissemination of publications and information;
- c) co-operation in the formulation of proposals for, and in the execution of, technical co-operation projects having components that fall within the competence and the expertise of the respective organizations;
- d) shared use of facilities, as far as practicable;
- e) continued accord for each others representatives and experts' observer status to attend and actively participate in meetings and conferences where subjects of specific interest to both organizations are being discussed, and;
- f) regular annual meetings between the IALA Secretary General (or representative) and the XXXXX Secretary General (or representative) to ensure continued co-operation and ongoing dialogue between the two organizations.

This Agreement should be reviewed and, where necessary, confirmed by future CIRM Meetings and IALA Councils as technological developments require.

Cooperation agreement between the International Navigation Association (PIANC) and the International Association of marine Aids to Navigation and Lighthouse Authorities (IALA)

The International Association of Marine Aids to Navigation and Lighthouse Authorities (IALA) and the International Navigation Association (PIANC), being aware of the growing need for close co-operation in the technical and regional development activities of common interest to both organizations and their Members, in order to enhance the impact on the international maritime environment, agree to:

- b) Elaborate technical and practical expertise by:
 - iv) Mutual representation in relevant technical commissions / committees;
 - v) Mutual notification of the terms of reference for working groups, subjects for congresses, conferences, seminars, workshops and other meetings;
 - vi) Setting up joint ad hoc working groups or invite participation on relevant working groups (e.g. Dictionary).
- c) Disseminate information by:
 - i) Publishing technical results (e.g. summaries of working group reports, committee meeting reports, conclusions and recommendations of congresses and conferences, symposiums, workshops and seminars);
 - ii) Publishing joint documents, as appropriate (e.g. Dictionary);
 - iii) Mutual announcement of events (international, regional, national) through hard copy and electronic means;
 - iv) Providing the possibility for each association to promote itself at these events (e.g. presentations, brochures, posters, etc.);
 - v) Creating and maintaining links to the front page of each others websites.
- d) Co-ordinate activities / input on international issues by:
 - i) Co-ordinating input to other international and regional bodies (e.g. IMO; European Commission; East African Commission) as appropriate;
 - ii) Co-organising of seminars/conferences.

Co-operation aspects cover all areas of mutual interest and includes:

- g) shared use of facilities, as far as practicable;
- h) participation at (up to two delegates free of registration fees):
 - a. PIANC – Congresses, Conferences and Annual General Assembly (AGA)
 - b. IALA – Conferences and Symposiums;
- i) the requirement to hold annual meetings between the IALA Secretary General (or representative) and the PIANC Secretary General (or representative) to ensure continued co-operation and ongoing dialogue between the two organizations.

This Agreement should be reviewed and, where necessary, confirmed by future PIANC and IALA Councils as technological developments require.
