<p>The e-Navigation concept, which has been proposed by IMO and IALA, is a key element for incorporating international standards for safety of ship navigation being undertaken by Southern Vietnam Maritime Safety Corporation (VMSS) for the modernization of maritime safety infrastructure in the VMSS management area, particularly in the busy area of Cai Mep Thi Vai (CMTV) deep-water port, located in southern Vietnam adjacent to the important international shipping lanes of the South China Sea.</p> <p>VMS-South has developed a modernization strategy that builds on the e-Navigation information service recommended by the IALA Academy's validation for the VMS-South Aid to Navigation System conducted in 2014.</p> <p>As a result of reports and investment proposals prepared by VMSS in 2014-2015, the CMTV area has been approved by the Vietnamese government for funding of modernization initiatives based on e-Navigation, including the establishment of an AIS aid to navigation system, automatic tidal and weather stations, and national electronic navigation charts (ENCs).</p> <p>The authors would like to share with IALA members their experience of policy development and technical work undertaken by VMS-South for the modernization of the Maritime Safety Section aligning with the e-navigation policy of IALA for Vietnam and developing countries.</p>
