Steve Nell's Scholarship

1 BACKGROUND

In accordance with the Industrial Members General Assembly's decision in May 2018, during the IALA Conference, a scholarship in Steve Nell's name has been established to support maritime AtoN education in Africa region, for an estimated amount of €10,000 per year.

2 USE OF STEVE NELL'S SCHOLARSHIP

2.1 In 2018

The fund has been used in full to cover some costs related to the Level1,1 AtoN course, held in France in September 2018:

- **Sponsored participant: Mr Kahou Paterne** (flight, accommodation and perdiem): €5,897.57
- **Costs of the SIRA training sessions** of AtoN managers + contract with CEREMA in France for organizing the course: €4105.43

2.2 Projections for 2019

The World-Wide Academy suggests using the Steve Nell's Scholarship as follow:

- **Level 1 course in South Africa, from 12 to 16th August 2019:**
 - Flight and accommodation for Johannes Natangwe MUZANIMA (Namibia)
 - Flight, accommodation and perdiem for Laura CHIRINDJA (Mozambique)
- **Level 1 course in Morocco, from 8th April to 1st May 2019:**
 - Flight, accommodation and perdiem for AYISSOU Levy Silver (Republic of Congo)

Adjustments may be done at the end of the year to respect the maximum annual allocation of €10,000.
