## 15 –MEMBERSHIP

### 15.2 –Resignations and changes in membership

Revised Note by the Secretariat

#### 1. BACKGROUND

Since the last Council session, the Secretariat received **five** formal resignations from membership and ~~three~~ **two** changes in membership.

#### 2. RESIGNATIONS FROM MEMBERSHIP

The following organizations have resigned from membership:

- **Jiangsu Koropp, People's Republic of China (4CHIN22)**: this organization has been an Industrial member since 2022. Further to a phone call after rejection of e-mails, the Secretariat was informed that the company has ceased its activities.
- **Horizonte AS, Norway (4NORV11)**: this organization has been an Industrial member since 2023. The resignation is due to financial difficulties in relation with the current market situation. They were informed that IALA, in their case, could agree for a payment of their membership fees in instalments. But they decided to maintain their decision. A first notification was received on 23 July and a confirmation was received on 7 November.
- **Fédération Française des Pilotes Maritimes, France (3FRAN08)**: this organization has been an Associate member since 2017. IALA was informed on 6 May 2024 that new President did not want to renew its membership. An attempt was made to keep them as a member, but without success.
- **Finnish Transport and Communication Agency, Finland (3FINL04)**: this organization has been an Associate member since 2019. The resignation is due to their integration into the Member State.
- **Swedish Transport Agency, Sweden (3SUED01)**: this organization first joined as a second National member in 2009, then they changed their category for Associate membership from 2014. The resignation is due to their integration into the Member State.

#### 3. CHANGES IN MEMBERSHIP

The following organizations have notified some for changes in membership:

- **Spartan Maritime (M), Malaysia (3MALA03)** has changed its name to **Lync Lab Sdn Bhd**.
- **Sarawak Marine Department, Malaysia (3MALA01)** has changed its name to Sarawak Buoys and Light Board.
- **Direction Générale de la Marine Marchande, Rep of Congo (1RCON01)**. Since they joined in 2015, no contribution was paid, and they were suspended by Council 69. They signed the Convention on 2022 and they attended the Conference in Rio in 2023. Their membership was about to be proposed for termination, but IALA received copies of their ratification on December 9, 2024.

**4. THE COUNCIL IS INVITED TO**
