New Draft Recommendation on Protection of the Built Heritage of Lighthouses and other Aids to Navigation

THE COUNCIL

RECALLING Article 8 of the [IALA] Constitution regarding the authority, duties and functions of the Council

RECALLING ALSO the work of IALA in encouraging the preservation of historic lighthouses and other aids to navigation of heritage value

RECOGNIZING the public interest in most countries to maintain and preserve structures of national heritage value

HAVING CONSIDERED the advice of the Engineering and Sustainability Committee provided to Council at its 64th Session

ADOPTS Recommendation IALA1020-R1002 on Protection of the Built Heritage of Lighthouses and other Aids to Navigation, as set out in the Annex

INVITES Members and marine aids to navigation authorities worldwide to implement the provisions of the Recommendation

REQUESTS the Engineering and Sustainability Committee to keep the Recommendation under review and to propose amendments as necessary.



ANNEX – Recommendation IALA1020-R1002 on Protection of the Built Heritage of Lighthouses and other Aids to Navigation

THE IALA COUNCIL RECOMMENDS that National Members and other aids to navigation authorities responsible for lighthouses and other aids to navigation structures which are of historical significance implement measures to ensure that such lighthouses and structures are, as far as possible, preserved and maintained as part of the global lighthouse heritage for the benefit and pleasure of future generations.
