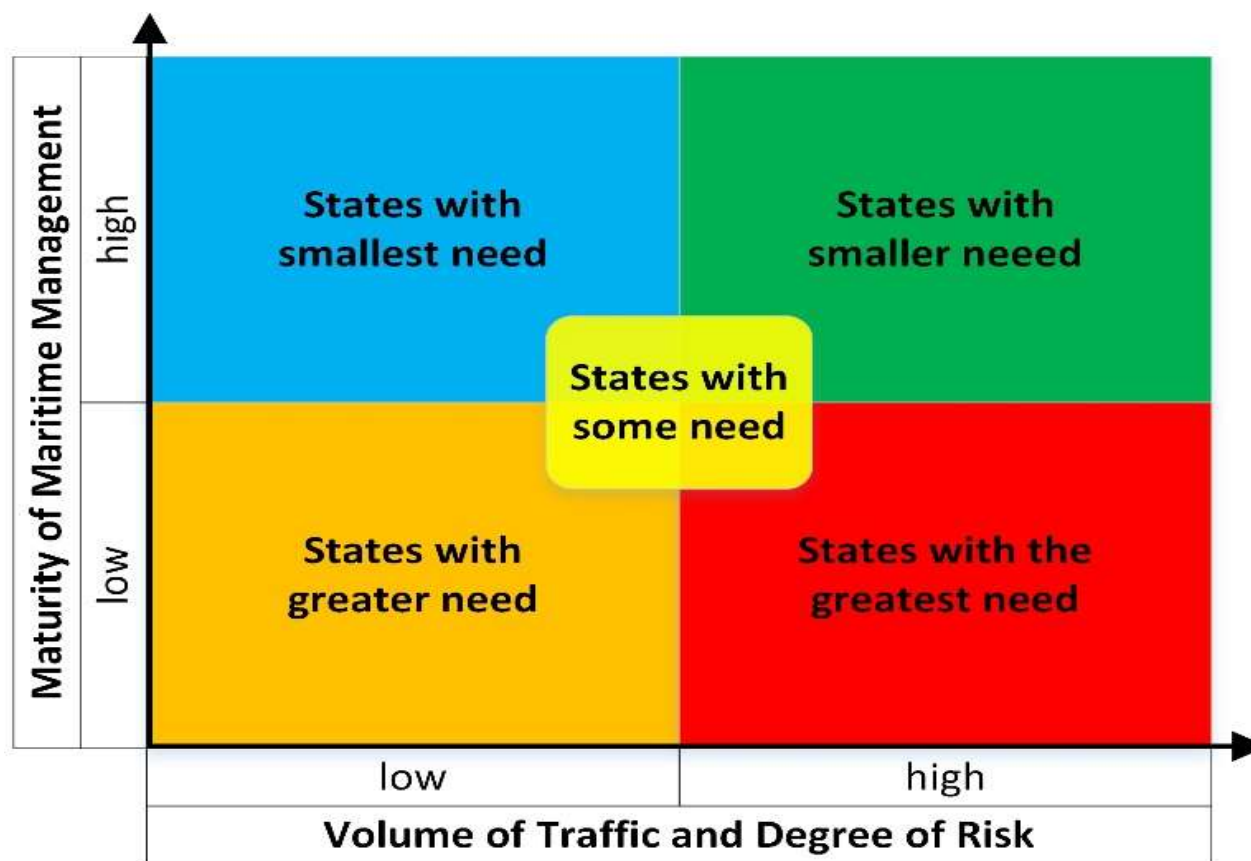

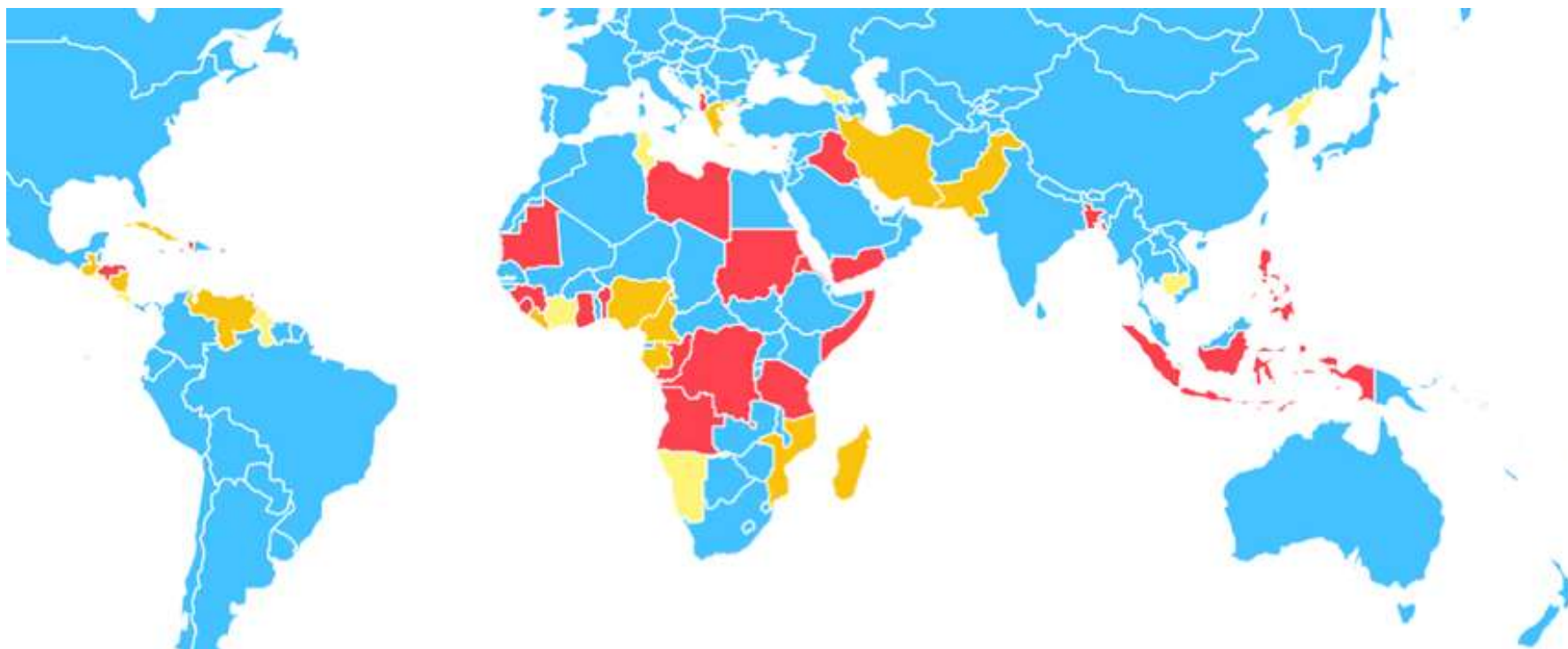
Capacity Building for VTS

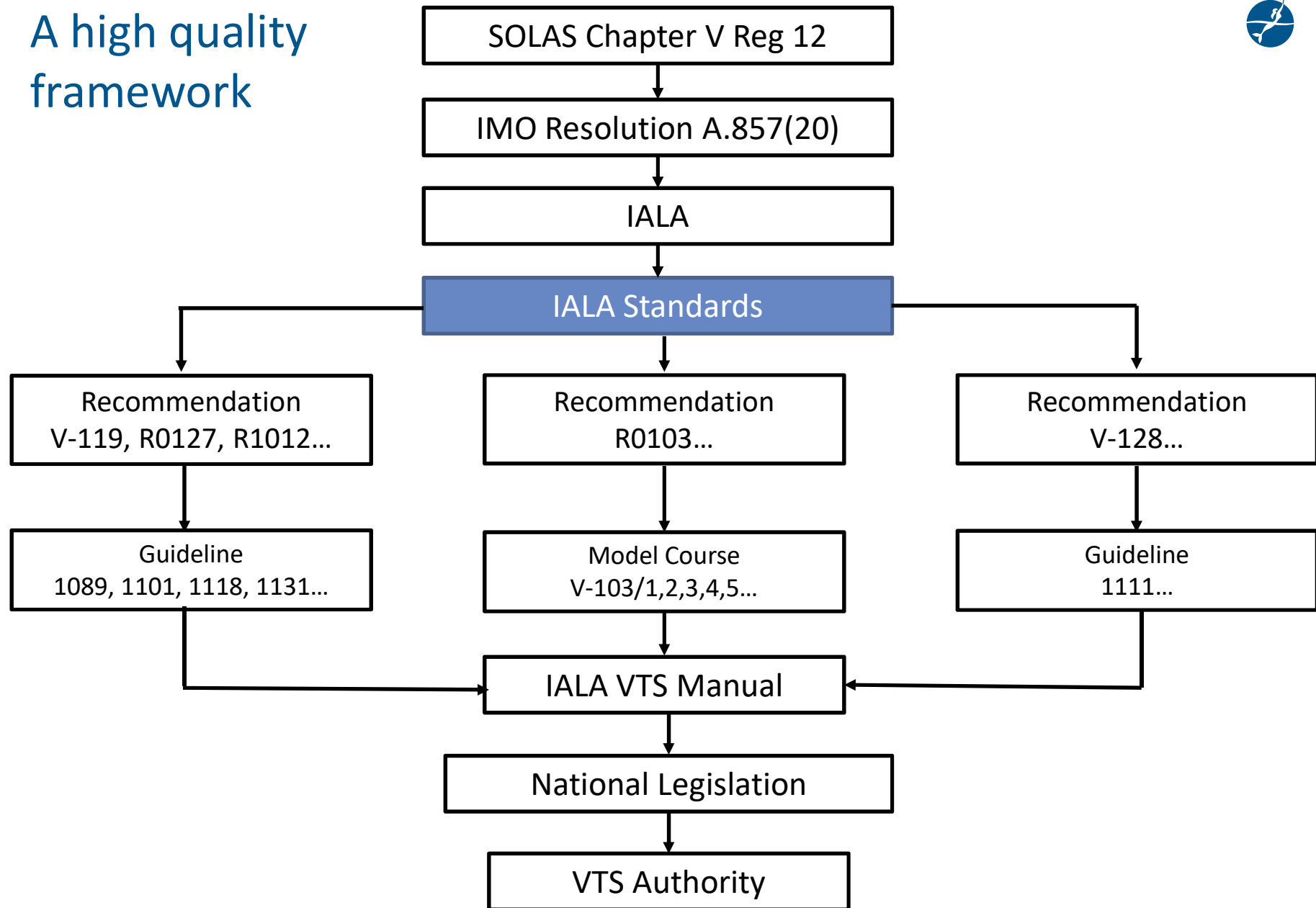

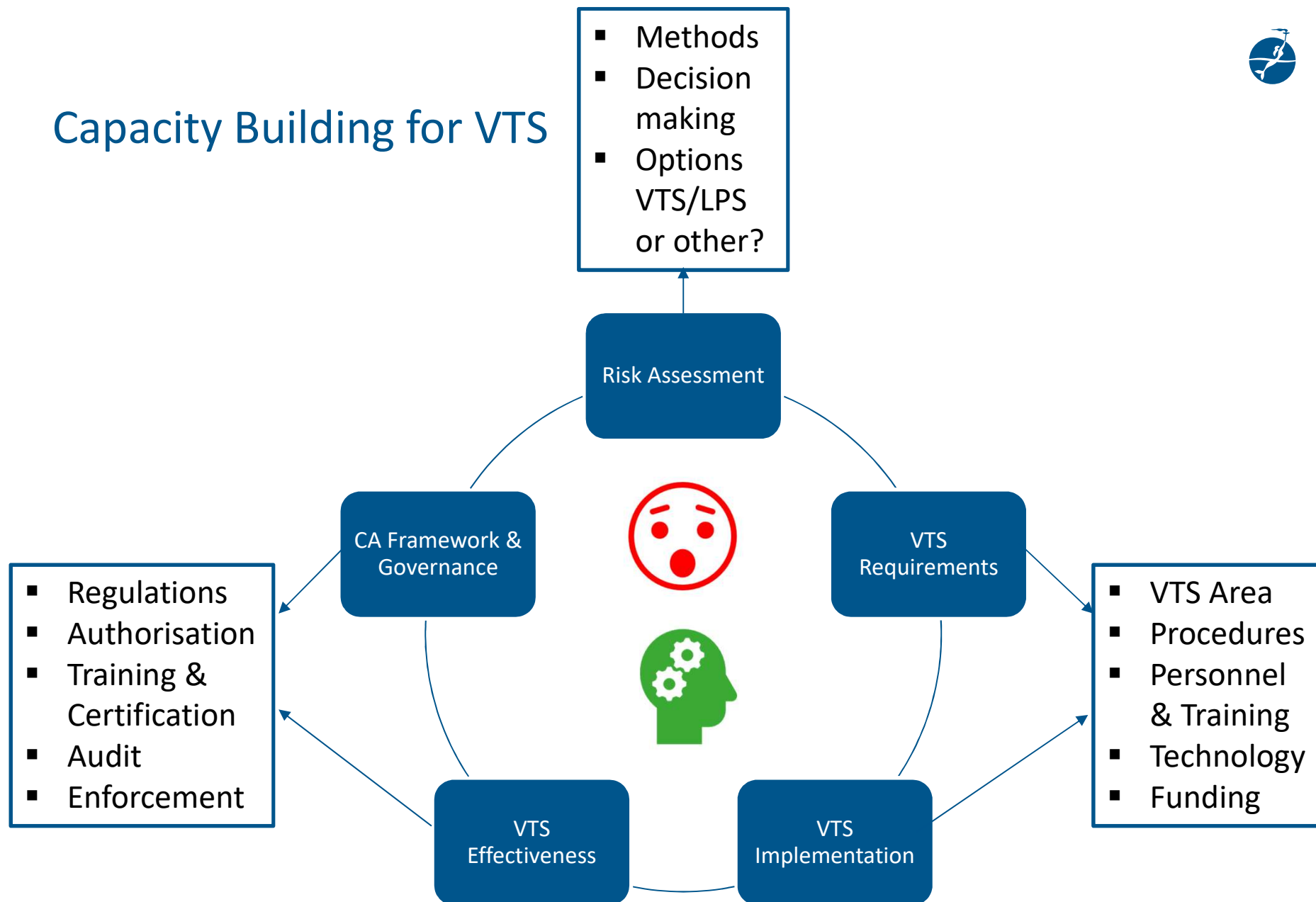

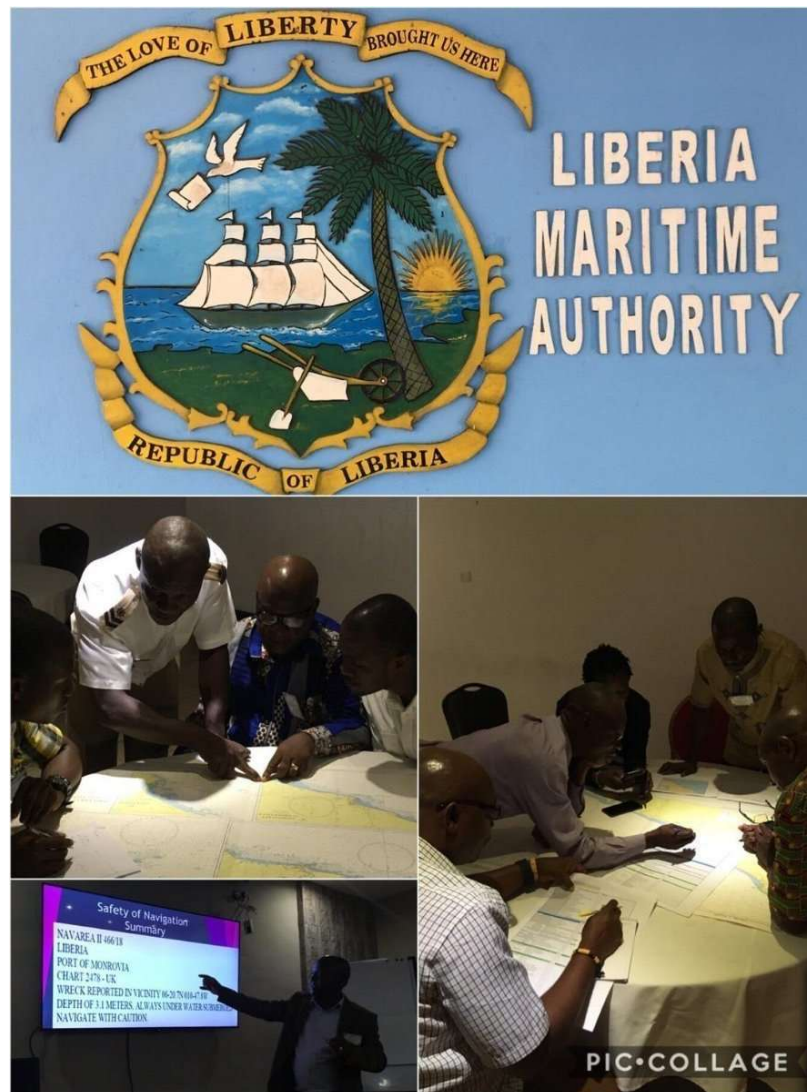
