##### Resignations from IALA Membership

The following organisations resigned since the last Council meeting.

##### National Members

- ***Cyprus Ports Authority; Cyprus.*** Due to severe administrative and budgets cuttings as a result of difficult economic circumstances, this Organization is not renewing, with regrets, its national membership of IALA for the year 2014. Discussions with their IMO Representative were initiated by the Secretary General. Fees are paid.

##### Industrial Members

- ***Pelangí International Ltd; UK.*** Further to the acquisition of Pelangi by Sealite Pty Ltd, the decision was made to keep only one IALA Membership, Sealite Pty Ltd in Sweden. This notice was received by 28<sup>th</sup> August with effect 1<sup>st</sup> January 2014. Fees are paid.
- ***Shanghai Navigation Aids Factory; Rep Pop of China.*** IALA was notified by 16<sup>th</sup> October that since the reforming of SNAF into a new company called CCCC Shanghai Dredging Co.; Ltd. and given the small part of AtoN in its new business, this new company is not interested to pursue the Industrial membership of IALA. Payments from the years 2010 to 2013 are overdue.
- ***Mediterráneo Servicios Marinos; Spain.*** This company has notified IALA of its resignation on 19 November, due to economic situation. A firm commitment was made to settle the two years outstanding fees as soon as possible and the re-apply when the company will recover good health.
