13-1 Applications for Membership

Note by the Secretariat

Since the last Council meeting, the Secretariat received the following applications for IALA Membership, which have been provisionally accepted by the Secretary General.

National Membership

Canadian Coast Guard, Canada. The Canadian Coast Guard has reinstated its national Membership of IALA. The contribution for the year 2014 was cancelled as they have not taken part to IALA activities for this year. The Canadian Coast Guard will officially be reinstated in our accounts from 1st January 2015.

Industrial Membership

- **Trelleborg Marine Systems, Sweden.** Application received on 8th July 2014. The contribution for this year is settled.
- **EDC Marine International FZE, UAE.** This company is a new manufacturer of AtoN and also an agent for Vega Industries in the Middle East and India Region. The application was received on 4th June 2014. The 2014 contribution is settled.
- **Seven Colour Electric Lighting Inc., Canada.** The application was received on 12th August 2014. And the membership contribution is settled.
- **Dongjoo Engineering Co., Ltd, Republic of Korea.** Application and support by the National Member were received on 08th October 2014. The 2014 contribution invoice was sent and is not settled to date.
