14.1 Applications for Membership

Note by the Secretariat

Since the last Council meeting, the Secretariat received the following applications for IALA Membership, which have been provisionally accepted by the Secretary General.

Industrial Membership

- **Kasi Malaysia Sdn. Bhd, Malaysia.** Application received on 13th April 2015. This company, which was an associate member of IALA since 2007, has expressed the wish to change its membership category in order to meet with its activity in marine industry and technologies in addition to port infrastructure development and marine consultancy. The additional contribution for the year 2015 is settled. Support was received from the National member
- **PT Warga Kusuma Jaya, Indonesia.** This company is specialized in VTS System integration with an extensive experience in maritime technology. Their application was received on 23rd January and the contribution is settled.
- **Xanatos Marine Ltd, Canada.** This company supplies customized sensor integrated vessel monitoring systems for ports, authorities and national security. The application was received on 2nd February. The contribution is settled.
- **Fendercare Marine Ltd, UK.** Application for Industrial membership received on 20th May 2015. This company, produces a range of navigation buoys and has operational bases around the world.
- **Jiangsu Xinhua Navigation Aids Co., Ltd., China.** Application form received on 21st May. This company was introduced by the National Member.

Associate Membership

- **UPnP Forum Board.** This organization based in the USA is an industry initiative of leading companies in computing, printing and networking, consumer electronics, home appliances, automation, control and security, and mobile products. Their goals are to allow devices to connect seamlessly and to simplify network implementation in the home and corporate environments. Their application was received on 28th January. The contribution is settled.
- **The Korea Research Institute of Ships & Ocean Engineering (KRISO), Rep of Korea.** This Organisation has been very supportive and active in the work of IALA under the umbrella of the National member and has formalized its application for associate membership on 25th March. The contribution is settled.

- **The Secretariat of the Pacific Community, *Fiji Islands*.** As a result of a technical visit of the IALA WWA for a Needs Assessment Mission of Aids to Navigation in Fiji from 16th to 24th February, this organisation has expressed the wish to become an Associate member of IALA. The application was received on 31st March and a provisional acceptance was sent out with a first contribution invoice. The payment is not received yet.

Change in Membership

- **Transas Marine International AB, *Russia*.** Due to organizational re-structuring, this company has transferred its activity to Transas Marine Limited based in Ireland which is now its sole shareholder.

Reinstatement of Membership

- **Resinex Trading Srl, *Italy*.** Since the last Council, this company which was notified its removal from IALA Industrial membership has immediately reacted by paying 2 years outstanding contributions, and they wish to keep their membership. A repayment plan for the remaining due is being proposed.
