1. INTRODUCTION

The 16th session of the Legal Advisory Panel (LAP16) was held from 11th to 13th April 2016 at IALA Headquarters.

LAP wishes to draw the Council's attention to items of particular importance considered during the meeting as listed below.

2. LAP16 SUMISSIONS TO THE COUNCIL

- A report on AIS data used as evidence at court cases was finalized after many years of work and the contribution of several countries. The report is submitted as an annex to the report of LAP16 as input paper C62-12.1.3 (LAP16 report is at input paper C62-12.1.2).
- IALA and China agreed that an IALA (IGO) General Assembly Resolution would address the One China Policy better than a MoU. A draft IGO GA Resolution is submitted for noting (input paper C62-12.1.4).
- The IALA Risk Register was reviewed and submitted for consideration together with a detailed note (input papers C62-12.1.5 and 12.1.6).
- LAP also reviewed the Academy Risk Register, the revised version of which is at input paper C62-12.1.7).

Consider the IALA and Academy Risk Registers.
