#### 16.1 – APPLICATIONS

##### Note by the Secretariat

#### 1. APPLICATIONS PROVISIONALLY ACCEPTED

Since the last Council meeting, the Secretariat received the following applications for IALA Membership, which have been provisionally accepted by the Secretary-General:

##### National Members:

- **Maritime Authority Suriname:** Application received on 11<sup>th</sup> April 2016, further to an assessment mission of the World-Wide Academy in the country.
