11.4.2 – Draft submission of an information paper to IMO NCSR 4 on the reporting and sharing of e-
Navigation testbed results

Note by the Secretariat

1. BACKGROUND

The Council, at its 62nd session in June 2016, approved revised IALA Guideline 1107 “Planning and Reporting of e-Navigation Testbeds, Edition 2.0.”

The E-Navigation Committee (ENAV), at its 19th session in September 2016 (ENAV19), recalled that IMO had issued MSC.1/Circ.1494 “Guidelines on Harmonisation of Testbed Reporting” in 2014. This guideline was based on Edition 1.0 of IALA Guideline 1107.

The ENAV Committee wishes to advise IMO of the publishing of a revised IALA Guideline and, at the same time, feels it can use the opportunity to also advise of the launching of IALA’s new website and a section therein that is the repository of all testbed information known to IALA.

After consulting with the representative of the IMO Secretariat at ENAV19, it was agreed that IALA could submit an information paper to 4th session of the IMO Sub-Committee on Navigation, Communication and Search and Rescue (NCSR4), advising of the above.

Approve the draft IMO information paper C63-11.4.2.1 for submission to IMO by 30th December 2016 (the deadline for submission of such papers).
