1. TERMINATION FOR NON-PAYMENT

The Secretariat continued its efforts to collect outstanding contributions from members through reminder letters or e-mail correspondence but these attempts were unsuccessful with six members, as listed in the table below.

Unpaid contributions since 2012 represent a total amount of €101,155. The loss for the years 2012 to 2016 will be compensated by the provision made in the balance sheet for bad debts and the 2017 invoices will be cancelled.

It is suggested that the Secretary-General, in a letter to these members, explains that the Council has decided to terminate their membership unless overdue contributions are settled before the next invoice is issued in October 2017.

Some National members are in arrears (Algeria, Gabon, Kuwait, Mozambique, Nigeria, Republic of Congo and Venezuela) but the Secretariat very much hopes that negotiations will yield satisfactory results by the end of the year. The successful procedure with a letter directly sent to the Director General or to the CEO of the authorities or companies will be continued.
