**11.4.4 – ENAV Committee papers for noting by the 65<sup>th</sup> Session of the IALA Council**

Note by the Secretariat

The following papers are submitted from the 21<sup>st</sup> session of the ENAV Committee (ENAV21) for noting.

- **C65-11.4.4.1 (ENAV21-14.1.8) Management of Maritime Resource Names (MRN).**

A concept of unique identifiers using Maritime Resource Names (MRN) for maritime resources has been developed, the principle of which facilitates global harmonisation of information flow in e-navigation which may potentially be adopted by the whole maritime community including IHO and IMO.

The use of unique identifiers is a necessary development of e-navigation to maintain harmonisation across domains and services. Navigationally unique objects such as aids to navigation, VTS products and services and other maritime services requires identification numbers to avoid duplication and misalignment of AtoN and Marine Safety Information (MSI).

IALA will provide a web site with all registered OID. IALA will maintain a database of all entries and provides this database as CSV file on the web site as well.

- **C65-11.4.4.2 (ENAV21-14.2.1) ENAV Work Plan revised at ENAV21**
