Draft work programmes have been created by the VTS and ENG Committees, and the ARM and ENAV Committees considered the work needed in 2018-2022 at their last meetings.

The PAP considered the work needed in 2018-2022 on new and revised Recommendations and the related work on Guidelines, and consolidated this into the Recommendations Plan for Standards – refer input document C65-8.2.4.1 Recommendations Plan.

PAP will develop the draft 2018-2022 work programme at its 35th session in February 2018. Refer input document C65-8.2.1.3 PAP planning to 2018-06.

The Secretariat envisages that Council would note the draft 2018-2022 work programme at its 66th session and approve the work programme at its 67th session, both being during the Conference in Incheon, Korea, in 2018.
