15.2 – Resignations from membership

Note by the Secretariat

BACKGROUND

Since the last Council session, the Secretariat received 7 resignations from **Industrial membership**. It is important to note here that these resignations were not made spontaneously, but as a reply to the reminders of unpaid contributions sent in April by email; it is not unusual at all to have some Industrial members resigning after an IALA Conference:

- **D.W Marine and Construction Pty Ltd, Australia.** This organization has been a member since 2012. Resignation was received on 30th April: due to a change in scope of work, they are no longer involved with marine aids to navigation.
- **IHM P/S, Denmark.** This organization has applied in 2016. The resignation is because of new perspectives.
- **Aqua Module, France.** This organization has been a member since 2018. The resignation was notified on May 2nd. Due to a scam, they will not be able to fully fill up their commitments as a member for sometimes.
- **Trimble Germany GmbH, Germany.** This organization has been a member since 2014. Resignation was received on May 6th due to a change in management and new perspectives.
- **Orolia A.S, France.** This organization has been a member since 2009. Their activity is no longer focused on marine aids to navigation. The resignation was received on April 24th.
- **Marine Data Solution, South Africa:** Member since 1998; as a reply to our reminder, IALA was informed on April 25th that: “the company is essentially non-existent/no business operations and all the staff has been retrenched” on 31st August 2018.
- **Spring Poland Ltd, Poland.** Member since 2006, this organization has decided to resign because of the IALA project on change of Status of from a NGO to an IGO.
