11.2.2 – Revocation of Guideline 1072

Note by the ARM Committee

**1. BACKGROUND**

As part of the ARM Work Programme, Task 5.2.1 requires the Committee to review Guideline 1072 on AtoN Information Exchange and Presentation and consider if the contents of Guideline 1105 on Shore-side Portrayal Ensuring Harmonisation with e-Navigation related information may be incorporated.

**2. SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS**

IALA Guideline 1072 on AtoN Information Exchange and Presentation (Dec 2009)

IALA Guideline 1105 on Shore-side Portrayal ensuring harmonisation with e-Navigation (Dec 2013)

**3. DISCUSSION**

A review of Guideline 1072 and Guideline 1105 was conducted by the Committee where it was concluded that the revision and restructuring of IALA Guidelines relating to portrayal and symbology (in both VTS and AtoN) for shore-based users are necessary.

The Committee concluded that both guidelines are point-in-time documents that have been overtaken by events. Therefore, the Committee recommends the revocation of Guideline 1072 and significant revisions to Guideline 1105, to be coordinated with the VTS Committee.

**4. THE COUNCIL IS REQUESTED TO**

**Approve** the revocation of Guideline 1072 on AtoN Information Exchange and Presentation.
