1. BACKGROUND

Since the last posting, the Secretariat received the following late submissions:

2. APPLICATIONS FOR MEMBERSHIP

2.1 For Industrial Membership

- **Anayurt Savunma San Ltd Şti, Turkey.** This organization was recommended by the National member and is specialized in wireless communications, signal processing algorithm, software and tracking systems. The application was submitted on 10 November and provisionally accepted.
- **PT Lestari Marina Utama, Indonesia.** This organization is a manufacturer of moorings and buoys. The application was submitted on 20 November and provisionally accepted.
- **Nash Maritime Ltd, United Kingdom.** This organization provides innovative solutions for shipping and navigation assessments in the ports, maritime infrastructures, offshore renewable energy and industries. Application was submitted on 11 November and provisionally accepted.
- **PT Geotindo Mitra Kencana, Indonesia.** This organization was introduced by Mesemar, Industrial member of IALA in Spain as a distributor of their marine aids to navigation products in Indonesia. The Application form was received on 30 November and they were provisionally accepted.
- **Koç Bilgi ve Savunma Teknolojileri A.Ş (KoçSavunma), Turkey.** This Organization was recommended by the National member, DGCS. They design, manufacture and develop technology oriented, unique services and solutions for underwater maritime with the aim to cover the global maritime sector. The application was submitted on 23 November and provisionally accepted.
- **Xanatos Marine Ltd; Canada :** This Organization first joined IALA in 2015. However, their membership was terminated by Council 68 in December 2018 for non-payment of contributions. They have recently settled the 4 years of contributions in order to have their membership reinstated and recover their seniority. They were given a provisional acceptance.

2.2 Associate Membership

- **The Sasakawa Peace Foundation, Japan.** This organization is a Research Institute both in policy and science perspectives aiming at the comprehensive management and sustainable development of the ocean. Established in 1975, it is formerly known as the Ocean Policy

Research Foundation. Introduction was made by the National member and the application and endorsement were received on 11 November. Acceptance by Council is awaited.
