9.4 – Membership contribution status

GENERAL STATUS OF MEMBERSHIP

As of 13th December 2021, IALA welcomed in total 24 new members, including:

- Fifteenth Industrial members
- Six Associate members
- Three new National members: Turks and Caicos Island; The Directorate General of Land and Maritime Transport from Lebanon; and The Gambia.

The Organization has also registered 9 resignations and 9 terminations. The total number of members is 321 which is six more than last year.

There is still K€601 to be paid for the 2021 contributions (+22% compared to last year) and K€237 for contributions in arrears (for the years 2018 to 2020) which is 28% less than in 2020 at the same period.

ACTIONS BY THE SECRETARIAT

During the year, the Secretary-General has, as approved by the Council, considered individual cases and waived part of the outstanding contributions, where appropriate:

- A free membership in 2021 for *The Directorate General of Land and Maritime Transport (Lebanon)*; for the industrial members *Navmoor Limited (United Kingdom)* and *DuckSung Ocean Development Co.,Ltd, Korea (Rep of)*. All joined IALA in August 2021.
- The waiver of the 2020 contribution and 66% of the 2021 contribution for *Safran Electronics & defence (France)* who suffered financial difficulties because of the pandemic.

SUSPENSIONS AND TERMINATIONS

A list containing outstanding balances is presented in Annex 9.4.1. This list includes members deprived of their membership rights by previous Council decisions.

Due to non-payment of their contributions, three Industrial members and one Associate member are now in a position to be removed from IALA membership list. The financial impact would be €66,360.

The decision to suspend or terminate membership for non-payment (see members in red in Annex 9.4.1) will be examined at item 15 of the agenda.
