10.2.1 – 2nd half 2021 Committees summary

Note by the Secretariat

1. INTRODUCTION

The virtual Committee meetings in the second half of 2021 were held from 16 September to 2 November for 8 weeks. The Secretariat upgraded the arrangements for virtual meetings further, and most of the participants were familiar with the virtual meeting systems.

This paper provides the summary and statistics of the Committee operations.

2. COMMITTEES SUMMARY

2.1. Committee durations

The second round of virtual Committee meetings gave IALA an opportunity to hold committees over a more extended period of time, accommodating the wide variety of time zones.

- VTS 51: 16 September - 31 March 2021; 16 days
- ENG 14: 4 October – 2 November 2021; 22 days
- ENAV 28: 11 – 29 October 2021; 15 days
- ARM 14: 15 -29 October 2021; 11 days

2.2. Number of participants and meetings

There were 481 participants from 37 countries and sister organisations, and 40 participants attended for the first time.

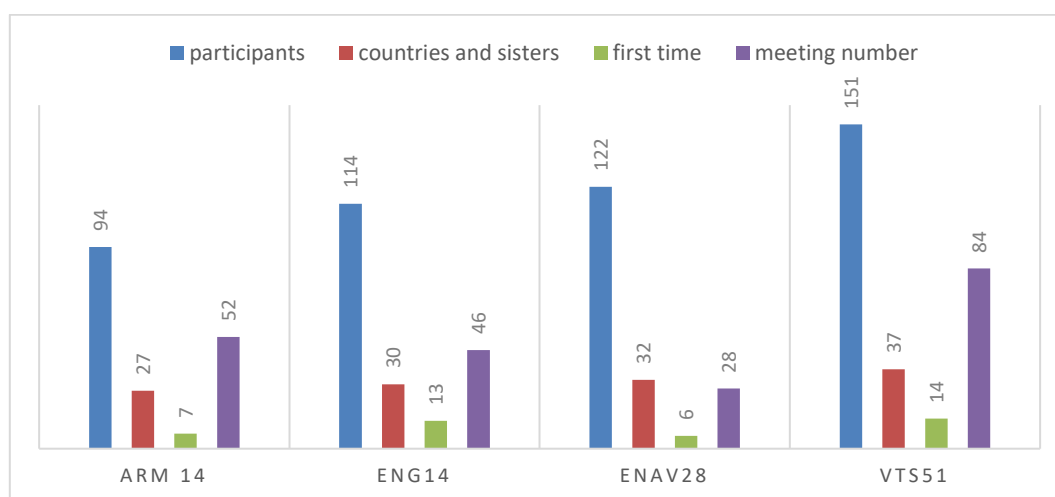


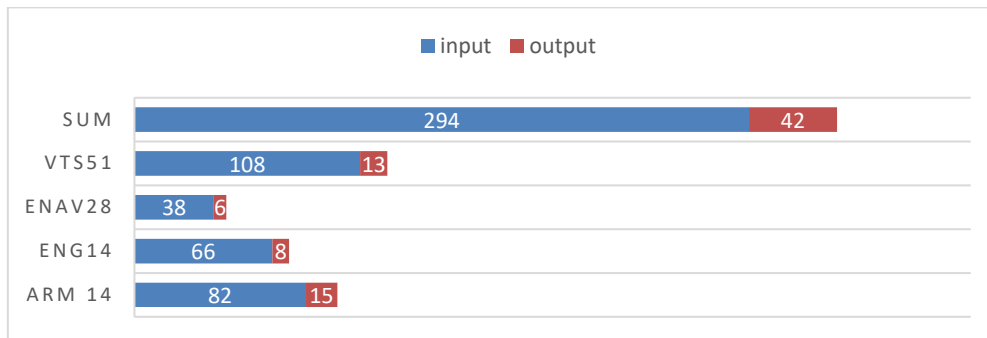
Figure 1 Total number of Committees participants



2.3. Work programme 2018-2023

The committees continued the work programme, and reviewed the document for the extended work period 2018-2023. The revised WP is prepared as C74-10.2.2.1.

The committees worked on 294 input papers and finalised 42 output papers, and 201 meetings were arranged during the period.



2.4. Presentation sessions

Many engaging presentations were made separately using the Microsoft Teams platform. It gave an excellent opportunity for the participants to hear other committees' topics. There were 14 presentations made during the committee period, and the link is;
