10.2.1 – Committee activities summary report

Note by the Secretariat

1. INTRODUCTION

The committee meetings in the second half of 2022 were held as a hybrid type from 16 September to 28 October for 7 weeks. That concluded the planned work period 2018-2023 except for ENAV's one more extraordinary session in Jan 2023 in IALA HQ.

The arrangements for the hybrid type committees have been very successful using the online facilities offered to the membership and the committee's dashboard hosted on the IALA website. Most of the participants were familiar with the virtual meeting systems, but still, there was some challenges for the online participants.

This paper provides a summary of the result of participants' survey results and works with some statistics on the outputs of the last 4 years.

2. COMMITTEES SUMMARY

2.1. Committee outputs for the work period 2018-2023

Because of the COVID pandemic, the work period was extended one more year (IALA CL14-2021) to 2023. The pandemic affected the committee meeting from the 1st half of 2022, and only ARM 14 could be held in Feb 2020, and ENG 14, ENAV 25, and VTS 48 were cancelled.

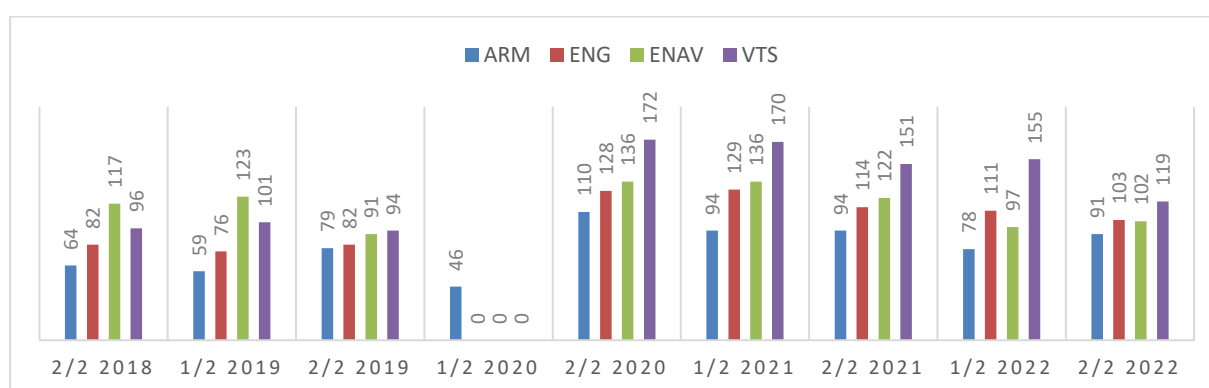


Figure 1 Number of participants 2018-2022

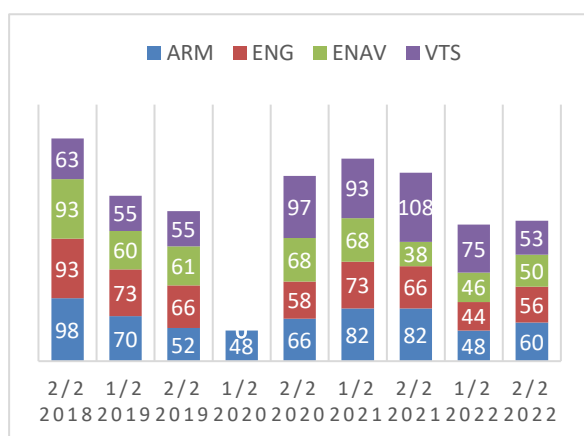


Figure 2 Number of outputs 2018-2022

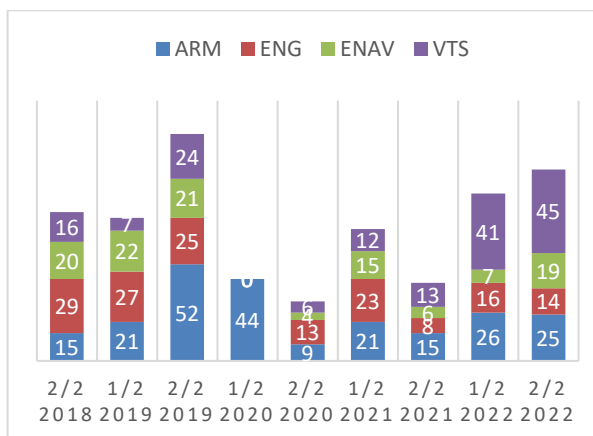


Figure 3 Number of inputs 2018-2023

2.2. Committee summary for the second half of 2022

The blended type of Committee meetings allowed for holding committees over a more extended period of time with virtual closing after the physical meeting weeks.

- VTS 53rd session: 16 September - 28 September 2022; 9 days
- ENAV 30th session: 26 September - 7 October 2022; 10 days
- ENG 16th session: 17 October - 28 October 2022; 10 days
- ARM 16th session: 24 October - 4 November 2022; 10 days

2.3. Participants survey

The Secretariat conducted participant feedback surveys after the committee meetings. Most of the answers were optimistic about the working arrangement, but some participants experienced difficulties when following the meetings online. These difficulties, however, mainly revolved around time differences. Many participants welcomed the opportunity to join virtually, and this has influenced the Secretariat's decision to continue with hybrid committee arrangements.

2.4. Presentation sessions
