### **INTRODUCTION**

In accordance with the Constitution Article 5.1 honorary membership may be conferred for life upon any individual who is considered by the Council to have made an important contribution to the work of IALA.

IALA has at present 46 Honorary members.

### **DISCUSSION**

The Swedish Maritime Administration and the Swedish Transport Agency would like to propose Commodore Barry Goldman, Younger Brother of Trinity House, Sister Organization from the International Harbourmasters Association (IHMA), for honorary membership.

This nomination is supported by the by the Councillor from the United Kingdom.

Commodore Barry Goldman CBE joined IALA as a participant of the VTS Committee in 2002. He has made vital contributions in the work of the VTS Committee over the past 20 years. He also played a key role in work items of major importance in order to harmonize VTS globally. Amongst all of this work, most notably are Guideline G1089 Provision of a VTS, Guideline G1166 VTS in Inland Waters and the new IMO Resolution A.1158(32) on Guidelines for Vessel Traffic Services. Following the introduction of the new IMO resolution he led the management and alignment of all VTS related IALA documentation to the new resolution. Commodore Goldman also served as Chair of Working Group 1 – Operations between 2006 – 2012 and has continued to provide his much appreciated expertise to the VTS Committee until recently retiring this year.
