## 15 –MEMBERSHIP

### *15.3 –Terminations and update on membership*

Note by the Secretariat

#### 1. BACKGROUND

Since the last Council session and after the Secretariat had exhausted all efforts to have the outstanding contributions settled with no success, the following organizations are in position to be removed from IALA membership.

#### 2. TERMINATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

- **Electronics and Telecommunication Research Institute**, Republic of Korea (*3RCOR02*): this organization owes three years of contributions. They joined in 2011 as Associate member.
- **Marine Transport Institute**, Democratic People's Republic of Korea (*3RPCO01*): since they joined in 2016 as Associate member, this organization has been facing difficulties to settle the contributions due to the embargo. They owe five years of contributions.
- **Chaohu Qunli Marine Anchor Chain Co. Ltd**, *The People's Republic of China* (*4CHIN12*): they owe two years of contributions and were waived the years 2019 and 2020 last year. They have been Industrial member since 2017.
- **Shandong Buoy & Pipe Industry Co. Ltd**, *The People's Republic of China* (*4CHIN06*): this organization has been an active Industrial member in the past. They joined in 2011, and they owe three years of contributions.
- **Qingdao Hotech Automated**, *The People's Republic of China* (*4CHIN19*): this organization has not settled any of their contributions since they joined as Industrial member in 2020. They owe three years.
- **Pesona Global Teknologi, Pt**, *Indonesia* (*4INDO09*): this organization has been an Industrial member since 2019. They owe three years of contributions.
- **Harmoz Berkeh Ertebat Electronic Gil**, *Iran* (*4IRAN04*): this organization has not settled any of their contributions since they joined in 2020 as Industrial member. They owe three years.
- **Navalec S.A de C.V**, *Mexico* (*4MEXI01*): this organization has been an Industrial member since 2019. They owe three years of contributions.
- **AD Engineering Limited**, *Papua New Guinea* (*4PAPO03*): this organization has been an Industrial member since 2018. They owe three years of contributions.
- **Maximum Protective Service Intl N.V**, *Suriname* (*4SURI01*): this organization has not settled any of their contributions since they joined in 2020 and although they attend the VTS Committee meetings. They owe three years.

### 3. UPDATE ON MEMBERSHIP

- **Office National de Signalisation Maritime, Algeria (1ALGE01).** No reply was received to the letter of the Secretary-General notifying this organization of the decision of the last Council to waive their debt and propose a cooperation under new basis. However, a short e-mail was received from the new Director recently seeking information on a possible review of aids to navigation. They were encouraged to answer this correspondence and make a formal request to IALA for further possible action.
- **Direction Générale de la Marine Marchande, Rep of Congo (1RCON01).** No reaction was observed since this organization was notified by letter of the Secretary-General of the decision of the last Council to waive their debt and proposal for cooperation under new basis.
