9.4 – Membership contribution status

Note by the Secretariat

GENERAL STATUS OF MEMBERSHIP

As of 15th November 2022, IALA welcomed in total 34 new members, including:

- Twenty Industrial members;
- Eleven Associate members; and
- Three new National members: The Gambia, Slovenia and Liberia.

Despite 12 resignations and 4 terminations effective on January 1, 2022, the total number of members has reached 338 (+6%).

IALA has received 94% of the contributions due for 2022 but there is still K€691 remaining due. Concerning the contributions in arrears (for the years 2018 to 2021), 44% have been collected and K€358 is still remaining due.

ACTIONS BY THE SECRETARIAT

During the year, the Secretary-General has, as approved by the Council, considered individual cases and waived part of the outstanding contributions, where appropriate:

- A free membership for the period September to December 2022 for the new industrial member **Chittagong Dry Dock Limited (Bangladesh)**
- A free membership for the period October to December 2022 for the industrial member **Dockyard and Engineering Works Limited (Bangladesh).**

SUSPENSIONS AND TERMINATIONS

A list containing outstanding balances is presented in Annex 9.4.1.

Due to non-payment of their contributions, eight Industrial members and two Associate members are now in a position to be removed from IALA membership list. They were suspended by Council 75 and still haven't paid their dues. The financial impact is €170,610 in total.

The decision to suspend or terminate membership for non-payment (see members in red in Annex 9.4.1) will be examined at item 15 of the agenda.
