Brief details on the National Matters of India for 80th Council meeting is as given below:

1. Development of tourism facilities at 75 Lighthouses.

Lighthouses, due to its natural and scenic locations, have tremendous tourist potential. In order to give impetus to promote tourism at Lighthouses. DGLL has established and managing 203 lighthouses along the Indian coast out of which 75 lighthouses have been developed with various tourism facilities in order to promote tourism in the country.

The tourism facilities developed at 75 Lighthouses includes components like museum, amphitheater, open air theater, cafeteria, children's park, gazebo, landscaping, selfie point etc. On February 28, 2024, the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India dedicated tourism facilities developed at 75 lighthouses to the nation, marking a significant milestone in the country's efforts to promote tourism and enhance coastal infrastructure.
