National Matters

Regarding the latest news from the Directorate General of the Maritime Territory and Merchant Marine (DIRECTEMAR), in the field of maritime signaling, we can mention the following:

In May 2024, we have successfully conducted, together with the IALA World-Wide Academy (WWA), the course L1.3 “Use of the IALA Risk Management Tools”, which was attended by 31 students from six Spanish-speaking countries and also had the valuable contribution of IALA instructors. We are very satisfied with the way the course was implemented and we hope to be able to do this again in 2025, as well as the L.1 course “AtoN Manager”.

Participation in technical committee meetings. We would like to inform that as of the cycle of meetings of the IALA technical committees during the first semester of this year, we have increased the number of personnel participating in the different committees, as a way of contributing our technical expertise to the development of the different topics that are being processed for the elaboration of IALA global publications.

Regarding the change of status of IALA, we would like to inform that the process of ratification of the Convention is at the stage of signature by our National Congress. The process is well advanced and we hope to have good news soon.

Seminar in Suriname, the IALA World-Wide Academy has kindly requested our support through the participation of speakers from DIRECTEMAR in a Seminar to be held in Suriname.
