##### 13.1.2 – IALA report on the second meeting of the IMO-IHO Harmonisation Group on Data Modelling (HGDM2)

Report by the Secretariat

### 1. INTRODUCTION

The second session of the IMO/IHO Harmonization Group on Data Modelling (HGDM) was held at IMO HQ London from 29<sup>th</sup> Oct to 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov 2018, chaired by Mr Hong Sunbae (R.O.Korea). The IALA delegation was headed by the Deputy Secretary-General, Michael Card, supported by the Vice Chair of ARM, Robert Lewald, the Chair of ENAV WG1, Axel Hahn, the Technical Operations Manager, Minsu Jeon and Jin-Gee Jeon as an observer.

IALA had submitted one paper as a Domain Coordinating Body for descriptions of Maritime Service (MS) 1,2,3 as following:

- HGDM 2/5/1 Draft descriptions for Maritime Services developed by WMO, IHO, IMPA and IALA

The group agreed to develop a draft MSC resolution containing the draft Guideline including the template for the submission of Maritime Services, and a draft MSC circular consolidating the descriptions of maritime services noting the need of updating and amending in due course.

### 2. GUIDANCE ON THE DEFINITION AND HARMONISATION OF THE FORMAT AND STRUCTURE OF MARITIME SERVICES

The guideline defines the terminology, responsibility and flowchart for the development of a new Maritime Service. Relationship between the different levels of service descriptions and relationship between Maritime Service and S-100 based product specification, are included in the guideline.

The draft will be sent to NSCR and MSC for the further approval process.

The draft includes the first consolidated descriptions of Maritime Services (Annex I) and Technical Services (Annex II) based on the references G1128 submitted to the meeting as outcomes of the IALA ENAV Committee. This circular invite international organisations and the interested Member States to work on the definition of the Maritime Services and Technical Services.

### 3. MS 4 LOCAL PORT SERVICE (LPS)

IHMA provided comments on the terminology of LPS which is already in use in context of VTS. IALA supported this proposal during the consolidation, and it will be discussed in NSCR 6 in Jan 2019.
