The website for the EU-funded STM validation project states

*The STM Validation Project will demonstrate the STM concept in large-scale test beds in both the Nordic and Mediterranean Seas. The key strategic enablers of STM will be tested and validated. The STM Validation Project has a total budget of approximately 43 million euro and runs from 2015-2018. The project encompass:*

*300 ships, 13 ports, 5 shore based service centres, 13 connected simulator centers in the European Maritime Simulator Network – EMSN*
