<b>PROPOSAL</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Seminar on the sustainable management of historical lighthouses as AtoN and cultural heritage in the context of the Incheon Declaration at 19<sup>th</sup> IALA Conference, held in Republic of Korea.</li> </ul>
<b>PURPOSE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Foster interest in lighthouse heritage globally.</li> <li>Raise awareness of historical lighthouses as cultural heritage.</li> <li>Support IALA efforts to sustainable lighthouse management through knowledge sharing, training and international cooperation projects.</li> </ul>
<b>POSSIBLE TOPICS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Technological changes in heritage lighthouses.</li> <li>Development of heritage lighthouses for tourism purposes and the opportunities and challenges in relation to same.</li> <li>Significance of historical lighthouses in the context of maritime culture and history, social history, and public interest.</li> <li>Opportunities and challenges in seeking UNESCO designation of lighthouses as World Heritage Sites.</li> <li>Impact of climate change on heritage lighthouses.</li> </ul>
<b>OUTCOMES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Input to the development of a World Heritage Lighthouse Cyber Centre.</li> <li>Input to the establishment of a database on World Heritage Lighthouses.</li> </ul>
