E- NAVIGATION USABILITY WORKSHOP

Event

To assist in the development of IMO's e-navigation strategy implementation plan, the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA), will host an e-navigation usability workshop on 5 and 6 March 2013.

The aim of the workshop is to further discussion and develop guidance on:

1. The usability of navigational equipment.
2. Quality assurance of software used in navigational systems (including updating regimes for software-driven applications).
3. Human element issues associated with e-navigation.

It is envisaged that the workshop will develop a draft methodology for evaluating the usability of navigational equipment. The workshop output will be submitted to IMO NAV 59, which will meet in September 2013.

Program

A program of sessions and topics to be considered is under development and will be made available via the IMO Correspondence Group on e-navigation, the IALA e-Navigation Committee and on AMSA's web site (www.amsa.gov.au).

Attendance

All interested parties are invited to attend.

AMSA extends a special invitation to the IMO and IALA membership, human factor practitioners, experts from other industries and equipment manufacturers.

The working language of the workshop will be English.

Workshop attendance is free of charge and includes the following:

- Workshop participation on 5 and 6 March (includes refreshments and a light lunch on both days).
- Welcome reception (5 March)
- Workshop dinner (6 March)

Delegates are responsible for arranging their own flights, airport transfers and accommodation.

An official partners program is not being planned. However, partners are welcome to attend the welcome reception and workshop dinner, for which there will be no charge.
